## 11.0 ARCHIVE

A medium-sized assemblage of ceramic and clay tobacco pipe and ceramic building material were recovered during evaluation (688; 591). The material is of late post-medieval to modern date and no further analysis is recommenced for the assemblages. A medium assemblage of lithic material (410) has been the subject of assessment and selected illustration has been recommended. A small assemblage of prehistoric pottery has been the subject of assessment and selected illustration and sherd consolidation has been recommended. A small assemblage of animal bone has been the subject of a specialist assessment and no further work is recommended for the material. 230 litres of soil were retained during fieldwork and have been the subject of full processing and assessment. Other finds of glass (81) metalwork (11), slag (1) and plastic objects (1) were of late post-medieval to modern date and no further analysis is recommended; a full index of all the material is available for consultation at FAS.

The site archive and material assemblages are currently held by Field Archaeology Specialists. A paper and electronic copy of the report will be deposited with the Heritage Unit of North Yorkshire County Council.
