1.0 INTRODUCTION

A total of 17 coins were submitted for identification, following cleaning and x-ray. The coins ranged in date from the late Roman period to the 18th century, and included sceats, stycas, pennies, half-pennies and jetons. The majority of the coins (9) were found to date to the late-7th to 9th century, with 14th, 15th, 17th and 18th century examples also represented.
